- We celebrate and value diversity and aim to provide a safe, happy and inclusive learning environment for all.

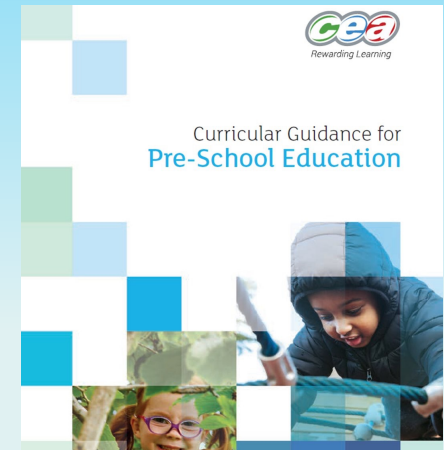


# The Pre-School Curriculum
